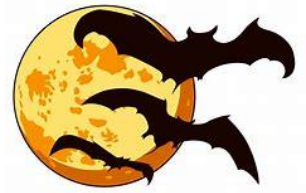

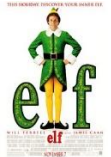
A **Veterans Day Breakfast** will be hosted by the city at CHCC, Friday, **November 9**, 8:30 a.m., with a recognition
